Put-ins & Parking

- 1. Eagle Bay Village & Parking at 1P (300)** - on Route 28 on the edge of Inlet and Eagle Bay (approximately 1 ½ miles south of Arrowhead Park). Drop-offs on the waterfront; parking on the lawn. Someone at this location will direct you where to park.
- 2. Clark's Marina & Parking at 2P (100)** - on Route 28 on the edge of Eagle Bay (1 mile south of Arrowhead Park). Drop-offs are at the marina's waterfront; all parking across the street and along Uncas Rd., North Star Rd., & at BJ Queen Enterprises. Someone at this location will direct you where to park.
- 3. Rocky Point Properties & Parking at 3P (165-200)** - on Route 28 between Inlet and Eagle Bay (approximately ½ mile south of Arrowhead Park). Parking will be across Route 28. Pull into Rocky Point to unload your boat and someone there will direct you where to park.
- 4. Crosswinds (300)** - on Route 28 just south of downtown Inlet (before the Cedar Creek Bridge on a large lawn). Someone at this location will direct you where to park along Route 28 with additional parking at 14P.
- 5. Peters Cottages (45-50)** - on Route 28 just south of downtown Inlet (after the Cedar Creek Bridge). Someone at this location will direct you where to park on the property & along Route 28.
- 6. NYS DEC Boat Launch - No Parking - EMS and Rescue Only**
- 7. Frisky Otter & Woods Inn Parking at 7P (60-80)** - on Route 28 in Inlet (3 buildings south of Arrowhead Park). This is reserved for those who have rented boats from Frisky Otter Tours.
- 8P. Birches-Volunteer Parking Only (20)** - on Route 28 (approximately 25 yards south of Arrowhead Park). This lot is for Registration Volunteers. Please park on the right side only.

- 9. Arrowhead Park & Parking at 11P & 9P & 14P (300-900)** - in the center of downtown Inlet. Pull in to unload your boat and someone there will direct you where to park with a 5 minute walk back.
- 11P. Community Church Parking for Arrowhead Park** - on South Shore Road. (less than ¼ mile from Arrowhead Park) When full use Fern Park 9P.
- 10. Screamen Eagle Pizza & Parking at Church Parking Lots (40)** - on Route 28 (approximately 275 yards from Arrowhead Park). There will be someone there to direct you to where to park.
- 11. Inlet Marina (100)** - First driveway on the right hand side on South Shore Road. Drop offs only, all parking at 9P.
- 9P. Fern Park** - on South Shore Road (approximately ¼ mile from Arrowhead Park). This parking area is for Spectators and those launching at Inlet Marina.
- 12. Holl's Inn (80-100)** - on South Shore Road (approximately ½ mile from Arrowhead Park). Pull in to unload your boat and someone there will direct you where to park on the property.
- 13. Eagle Cove (50)** - on South Shore Road (approximately 1 mile from Arrowhead Park). Pull in to unload your boat and someone there will direct you where to park on the property and across the road.
- 14P. Murdock Trucking (400)** - 1 mile north to Limekiln Road then 1 mile in on the right.

Each boat must paddle out to one of the 5 barges with the balloons and get a numbered sticker before entering the square in order to be counted for the record.

Rules for Guinness Attempt

- Each canoe, kayak or guide boat within the raft must have at least one person in it.
 - Inflatable canoes/rafts are not permitted.
 - The canoes/kayaks/guide boats can only be held together by hands. No craft can be lashed to another by ropes.
 - The whole raft must free float on a body of water or river for at least 30 seconds. If at any time during this period the raft is grounded, touches land or any other craft, the attempt is disqualified.
 - The raft cannot be attached to any other craft or jetty, but can be during the assembling of the raft.
 - The record is based on the total number of canoes, kayaks and guide boats in the raft, not the number of people involved.
- No dogs on the raft**
- PFDs must be worn**
